

Find the answers to the clues below. The letters in boxes will be used to solve your Unlock It! adventure.

CLUE	As you begin your Unlock It! adventure, you'll find a sign behind The Marsh building describing the importance of the wetlands you are about to enter. In a wetland, what protects the shorelines from erosion?

CLUE	Keep following the path to the west, and stay to the left at the fork. Walk around the loop, and on the way back, you'll find a bench. Count how many wooden slats make up the back of the bench and spell out the number.

CLUE	Walk back to the east side of the building and take the path to your right. Notice that the path forms an outside perimeter to a grassy "island" area. How many trees do you count inside that grassy island area?

CLUE	Take the small path to the right. You have to watch your step, or you will trip on these, which keep the trees in the ground and absorb the nutrients to help the tree grow.

CLUE	When you come to the T, take a left and walk toward the boardwalk. Cross the boardwalk. Look for a sign near the entrance to the park. What is the name on the sign?

CLUE	Reverse course and follow the gravel path out onto an island in the Marsh. Once there, find your way down to a dock on the waterway and take time to enjoy the peace of being in this beautiful spot. When ready to proceed, walk up the steps, saying the alphabet, one letter per step. Stop one step before the top and write down the letter that step represents as the answer to this clude.

CLUE	Follow the trail back to the grassy hill. Take the small walking path near the top left of the hill. On this path you will circle the island and find your way back. If you find different trails, be adventurous. All trails lead back to the path. Head back toward the boardwalk. Once on the boardwalk, take a break to gather your bearings. Complete the blank compass below by writing in the correct cardinal directions.

	Once you have done this, decide which direction you can see the farthest. Circle the third letter of that direction and write it here as the key letter to this clue.
CLUE	Continue on the paved path, passing the small path on the right where you came from originally. As the path approaches a roadway, find the "Planting for Pollinators" sign which explains that "animal partners pollen between flowers as they feed."
